***FINAL REMINDER* Diocesan Bilingual Prayer Evening for Survivors of Clergy Sexual Abuse – March 14, 2025**

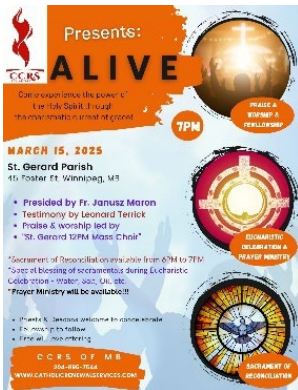

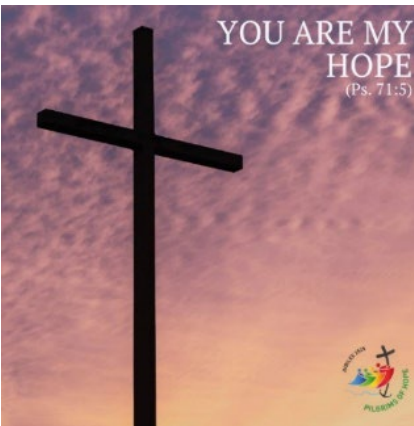

REMINDER 24 Hours of the Lord – March 28 & 29, 2025

Each Jubilee has its own particular way of being lived, according to the Holy Father's intention. This Holy Year is the Jubilee of Hope, in which everyone, wherever they are in the world, is invited to become "Pilgrims of Hope."

The love of God who always wants to come toward us and give us the grace of his forgiveness and mercy gives rise to hope in us as a gift of the Holy Spirit. In fact, forgiveness is the sign of love, its culmination, because it is offered to us as a free gift that allows us to live a new, "merciful" life, as Pope Francis says.

The purpose of the event is to put the sacrament of reconciliation back at the center of the pastoral life of the Church, and therefore of our communities, our parishes, and all ecclesial realities.

On the evening of Friday, March 28, and throughout the entire day of Saturday, March 29, parishes are invited to consider having an extraordinary opening of the church, offering the possibility of access to **Confessions**, preferably in a context of

Eucharistic Adoration. As always, the event could begin on Friday evening with a Liturgy of the Word to prepare the faithful for Confession, and conclude with the celebration of anticipated Sunday Mass on Saturday afternoon.

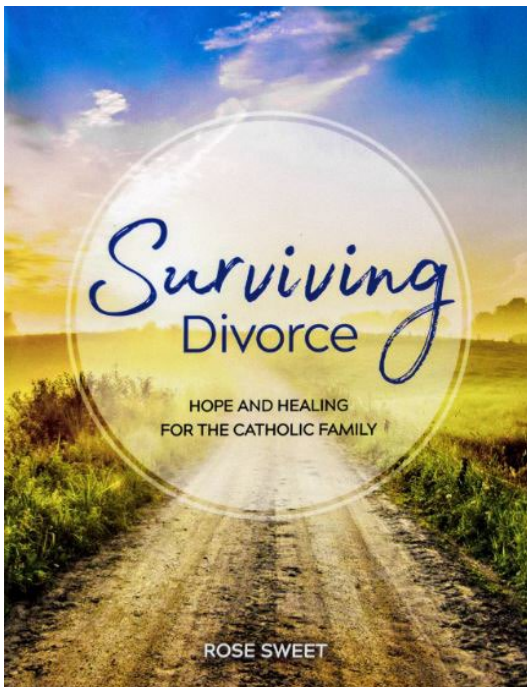
