\*NEW\* Winnipeg Free Press: 'A sense of the unfathomable' - Roman Catholic prayer service focuses on church abuse victims

"Unfathomable." That's the word Albert LeGatt, archbishop of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of St. Boniface, repeated multiple times last week during a prayer service that may have been the first of its kind across Canada — focusing on survivors of sexual assault committed by clergy.

"When I think of this whole reality of sexual abuse, that's the word that comes to mind," LeGatt told about 75 people at Christ the King Parish on St. Mary's Road.




